Frequently Asked Questions

What recommendations are there for laying the MAP out?

This is a helpful table which many churches have used or adapted:

What	Why	Who	When	Review	Completed

If we use a structure different to the diocesan priorities of discipleship, evangelism and vocation (DVE), how do you label an item D, V, or E and what if items mix all three?

Alongside each item on your MAP put the initial D, V, or E to indicate which it comes under. If it is a mixture of two or all three, then put the initial first of the primary priority eq VDE or EDV.

What do we do when we have written the DVE MAP?

- 1. Agree it. The MAP must be owned by the PCC and/or DCC.
- 2. **Communicate** the key ideas of your MAP to the whole congregation and promote prayer towards achieving it e.g. a sermon series on the key points, display, leaflet, PowerPoint Presentation. Each church/fresh expression will do this differently but it is a vital part of the whole exercise.
- 3. **Resource** it. Make sure that areas which need resources of people or finance have these provided.
- 4. **Do** it and review it.
